AUCTION POLICIES

REPRESENTATION OF CARS

If the car is not properly represented, file a complaint at the arbitration window and GET A DECISION before leaving. All cars registered here are subject to inspection by the Georgia Bureau of Investigation, the Federal Bureau of Investigation, National Auto Theft Bureau, Local Police and Auction Inspectors. Any car that has an "AS IS" sticker that does not match the Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) or has a mutilated or illegible "AS IS" sticker must be checked by the Auction Inspectors before it may be offered for sale. Auction Management reserves the right to void any transaction.

ODOMETER POLICY

We will require Sellers to repurchase any vehicle with a documented odometer problem. The Seller will be required to pay the purchase price, reasonable transportation, expense cost and all auction fees.

ARBITRATION POLICY

Any price adjustment eliminates further arbitration for mechanical defects.

INTERPRETATION OF POLICY

In matters of Interpretation of Auction Policy, the decision of Auction Management shall be final.

SALVAGE AND BONDED TITLES

If a vehicle has had a previous Salvage Title and has been repaired in accordance with state law to issue a clear title, this must be announced at the time of sale and sold under the Red Light. Bonded Titles must be announced.

ADVANCE REGISTRATION POLICY

Please register your vehicle for sale in as far advance as possible. All other vehicles are first come first serve on auction days. No phone registration is allowed on sale day.

All registration fees are payable the night of the auction unless prior arrangements are made. No shows will be charged for numbers not used. Numbers are not transferable.

Wednesday registrations are firm registrations with full descriptions. There is no credit for cancellations. Any substitutions can be done up until 5:00 P.M. on sale day. Auction policy is to provide fair and equal opportunity to all customers and the privilege of registration in advance will be extended to a customer as long as it is not abused.

PUBLIC SELLER POLICY

All vehicles sold by Public Sellers are required to have the title present at the time of the sale. The title must be printed in the Seller's name on the front of the title by the State. No open titles are allowed. Sellers will be responsible for Seller's fee plus the Buyer's fee on all lost deals from unannounced title attached sales.

GENERAL POLICIES

1. All Dealers must be licensed in their state and registered at this auction before doing business.
2. All cars bought and sold on the auction premises must be paid for through the auction office.
3. It is the Seller's obligation to correct any errors made by the auction as to announced "Conditions". It is the Buyer's obligation to watch the lights and listen to announced "Conditions".
4. Cars selling for \$2000.00 or less become "AS IS" and are not subject to arbitration for any reason other than frame damage, odometer discrepancy or salvage/rebuilt titles unless otherwise announced.
5. No vehicle will be offered for sale without a valid Vehicle Identification Number plate.
6. The Buyer is responsible for verifying the serial number, model year and odometer reading and that the odometer is working before leaving the sale.
7. The Auction does not guarantee the year of any house trailers, recreational vehicles, antiques, motorcycles, boats and boat motors, or reconstructed vehicles.
8. Motor homes must be sold announcing the model year of the chassis and the model year of the body.
9. Damaged and repaired frames must be announced under the Red Light. Frame damage or frame repair should be reported to the auction within seven (7) days from the date of the sale.
10. All OUTSIDE SALES are between the Buyer and the Seller. All are "AS IS" and cannot be arbitrated for any reason.
11. Any purchase other than "Under the Hammer" is considered an Outside Sales transaction.
12. All vehicles must have a **Paid Gate Pass** before leaving the premises.
13. The auction is NOT LIABLE for any state tax or ad valorem tax.
14. Any vehicles that are grey market, kit cars and any reproduction vehicles must have a valid Georgia registration. All of these types of vehicles will be sold "AS IS" and are not subject to arbitration.
15. Any vehicle sold through The New Calhoun Auto Auction must have a title and tag receipt. The tag receipt must match the decal on the car.
16. Any vehicle sold with Salvage History or a Salvage Title must be repurchased by the Seller if not disclosed up front. Any legal situation that may occur on Salvage Vehicles or titles is strictly between the Buyer and the Seller. The New Calhoun Auto Auction is not responsible.
17. **YOU MUST REGISTER BEFORE THE AUCTION AND HAVE YOUR BIDDER NUMBER VISIBLE AT ALL TIMES.**
18. Do not tamper with the accessories or attachments on the vehicle such as the radio, windows, sunroofs, tops, ect. **Do not remove the keys for any reason.**
19. Payments are accepted in CASH OR CREDIT CARD. If you choose to pay by credit card, a 3% Buyer's premium surcharge will be added to the transaction. A check will be accepted only with a completed and approved check authorization letter from your bank. The authorization letter must be on the bank's letterhead and dated for the day of the sale.
20. **ALL PURCHASES MUST BE PAID IN FULL BEFORE YOU LEAVE THE PREMISES.**
